

Transfer of flights from Air Canada to Air Canada rouge™

As Air Canada transfers more flights to Air Canada rouge's network, you may receive a schedule change notification as a result of the change to the operating carrier for your customer's itinerary.

Here is what you need to know:

- You will receive a schedule change notification *even if* there is **no change** to the cabin, time, date or routing, indicating your customer has now been transferred to the Air Canada rouge flight.
- If your customer elects to make an alternate travel choice, you may process a refund for the PNR.
 When processing the refund request, please include the following in the OSI field: INVOL DUE SKCH ACP 672797
- If there is a change to the time, date or routing, you may handle as outlined in Air Canada's Schedule Change policy
- If your customer is accommodated in a different cabin as a result of the transfer, for example: from Business Class on Air Canada to Premium rouge, please process as outlined in Air Canada's Schedule Change policy.
